1st Semester, Academic Year 2023

Qualifications and Conditions

1. Not having deduction of 20 points or above of conduct scores.
2. Not having more than 2 SIIT student IDs.
3. No outstanding balance with SIIT.
4. Must resign from old student ID before the registration process for new student ID.
5. Admission will be considered from the scores they are used in the first admission to SIIT and the scores must be valid not more than 2 academic years (for the applicants who have submitted portfolio and scores in TCAS3 Round, they must submit other type of the scores for consideration instead).

Required Documents for Online Application (application period: 12 – 16 June, 2023)

1. Re-Admission Condition Letter (signed by the guardians and applicants)

2. Copies of citizen ID card or passport (foreign applicants) of the guardians and applicants
3. SIIT transcript
4. A copy of High School transcript.
